### Reports:

#### NRCS Report: Josh Elke

NRCS has two new positions, a senior Soil Conservationist, as well as a Biologist. Engineering staff will come from Redmond. There are now 3 positions NRCS is supporting through partnerships, including one with KWP. Their new Fiscal Year starts in October. This year NRCS signed 5 contracts with landowners, with projects totaling around \$1 million. They currently have 45 contracts in total, with about 40% being behind schedule. For FY 2024, they are focusing on Irrigation Conservation & Drought Resilience as well as Juniper Removal in the Olene Gap. Both areas of focus will require about three-quarters of a million dollars each in projects.

#### **ODA Report: Nina Andrews**

There is a new Senate Bill 85 regarding CAFO operations. It will be mostly applicable to new or renewing CAFO's and may put a cap on livestock water available. The new biennium has begun and ODA will need quarterly reports on time. Biennial reviews are also coming up soon, most likely in December or January for the Klamath and more towards the spring for the Lost River area. TMDL's for temperature are not being revised in this area, even though they are being revised in other areas. DEQ is in pending litigation regarding everything below the Upper Klamath Lake. There may be some new reporting requirements for SWCD's, in order to create measurable objectives and track success on projects. Two site visits were completed with ODA and SWCD on the Williamson, with cooperative landowners.

## FSA Report: Emily Trumbull

The FSA has wrapped up acreage reporting. Livestock programs are at one monthly payment right now. There is an organic program offering \$750 rebates with a deadline of October 1st.

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#### **New Business:**

- Jolene Moxon brought up Farm Bureau training, there is an Ag Leadership class with applications open this month. It is a state-wide training program with a variety of focus areas and Jolene highly recommended it after completing it herself. The cost is \$2,500 per person and can often be sponsored.
- The district will need to do Will's evaluation soon. The board also needs to conduct employee evaluations, and look into the raise policy in the Employee Handbook.
